Every year, 26 Jewish teens get the opportunity of a lifetime: a free Fellowship-year experience, beginning with a summer in Israel, in which they embark on transformative, deeply personal journeys. **Inspired by a stellar faculty of Rabbis and educators, Fellows explore existential questions and Jewish ideas while building friendships with peers who are as curious as they are, joining a lifelong community that inspires them to change the world for the better.** They also expand their worldviews through intensive encounters with a parallel

group of Israeli peers.

The Fellowship begins with a free, immersive summer in Israel in the summer between the Fellows' junior and senior years of high school, followed by monthly virtual experiences and a winter and spring seminar in the United States. Fellows continue their association with the Fellowship through our extraordinarily active, 1,400+ alumni community.

Eligibility and Important Dates

High school students in the 11th grade who self-identify as Jewish and who are from the United States or Canada are eligible for the Fellowship. The Fellowship begins the summer after 11th grade.

- **Application Deadline: December 5, 2022**
- **Summer Seminar: July 3, 2023 – August 4, 2023***
- **Winter Seminar: December 11 or 12, 2023 – December 14, 2023***
- **Spring Seminar: March 29, 2024 – April 2, 2024***

The Bronfman Fellowship Year at a Glance

The Bronfman Fellowship is a transformative, year-long experience for a cohort of 26 intellectually adventurous young people who want to see the world through a lens broader than their own. It includes:

- **An immersive summer in Israel** – In between their junior and senior years of high school, Fellows encounter the land and people of Israel, study major issues in contemporary Jewish life, and meet with some of today’s most influential figures. Inspired by a diverse faculty of Rabbis, educators, and artists, the Fellows have the opportunity to immerse themselves in a wide range of Jewish texts and ideas as well as artistic workshops.
- **Monthly virtual meetings** – Opportunities for reflection, deep dialogue, and processing with the same small group of Fellows and a faculty member.
- **Winter Context Seminar** – A collective retreat in December in the Northeastern U.S., in which the Fellows continue to learn and build relationships, and meet up with the Israeli Fellows who visit the U.S. at this time.
- **Spring Seminar** – Several days in the spring when the Fellows and faculty meet in a Northeastern U.S. city – generally NYC or Washington D.C. – to explore American Jewish identities.
- **Beyond Bronfman process** – Fellows choose a question, topic, or idea from their Fellowship summer that they would like to explore further. When they return home, they embark on a process of deep exploration with the help of alumni, staff, and faculty.
